NOTE: Procedures for response to requests concerning Non-Domestic animals, with exception of deer.

RESPONSIBILITY		TASK
Animal Control Officer	1.	The City does not handle live or dead non-domestic animals, with exception of deer.

NOTE: City staff does not have, or provide any training or certification as required by Texas Parks and Wildlife to provide services with respect to non-domestic animals.

Animal Control Officer, cont.

The City will no longer provide traps to residents for removal of non-domestic trapped animals.

NOTE: Commercial service companies are available to residents to handle or remove non-desirable non-domestic animals or pests.

Animal Control Officer, cont.

- 3. The City will pick-up dead or injured deer from the City's right-of-way, or with resident's permission on resident's property under special circumstances.
- 4. Pick-up of dead or injured deer will be from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday Friday during regular City business days. Pick up is not available on Weekends or Holidays.

Residents

- 5. Requests for pick-up of dead or injured deer are to made to:
 - Police Dispatch at 830-598-4818

Residents, cont.

- 6. For other dead non-domestic animals (wildlife), two options are available for disposal
 - Double bag the animal and place it into resident's trash container for pickup on normal trash collection day.
 - Double bag the animal and dispose of the animal in the trash container behind the police station.

Police Officers

The Police department will respond to non-domestic animal calls if there is a health or safety issue.

IF:

Requests for pickup of non-domestic animals are received by other staff,

THEN:

Direct caller to contact Police Dispatch at 830-598-4818

IF:

Requests for pickup of non-domestic animals, outside City limits, are received by other staff

THEN:

Direct caller to contact Burnet County Animal Control @ 512-756-8080
