

HARVESTER CHECKLIST - October 2025

WAC Harvester Support (830) 265-1803

Pre-Hunt Preparation

- Park in a conspicuous location or adjacent to the harvest site.
- Wear at least 400 sq. in. of blaze orange AT ALL TIMES.
- Ensure all bolts/arrows: (air bows for rifle season only)
 - Use minimum 1.5" fixed or mechanical broad heads.
 - Must be labeled with your name and address (LED nocks recommended).
- Use a harness when hunting from a tree stand only (required).

Shooting Conditions

- Deer must be in front of the provided backstop before shooting.
- Do not shoot if pedestrian or vehicle traffic is visible/audible on nearby roads.
- If harassed, please film encounter for GSPD

Post-Shot Procedure

- You have 35 minutes to retrieve/secure the deer, otherwise call the WAC number for help.
 - If deer expires off the harvest-site, attempt to notify the owner first, if unsuccessful call the WAC number for help.

After Securing the Deer

- Continue hunting if desired.
 - Care for the animal properly.
 - If hot and no cooling available, proceed directly to the deer shed.
- Absolutely no field dressing allowed at harvest locations.

Processing & Documentation

- Take harvested animals to the deer shed and present all bolts/arrows used in the harvest. Report any unfound bolts/arrows and missed shots.
- Complete MLDP information for each animal.
 - Tags will be issued after completion, properly tag your harvest.

Processing Options

- You may field dress at the deer shed and use the City disposal area.
- Or, you may take the deer for private processing, following state law.
- If donating the deer, hang it in the City cooler.
