Deer Management Program - October 2, 2017 through February 28, 2017
Venison Distribution Process is changing.

Last year during the Pilot Program, the members of the Deer Management Team tried to keep a list of those individuals who wished to receive a donated animal. This process was inefficient, time consuming and awkward.

This year, the Committee members will hold Venison distribution nights each Thursday (excluding holidays and severe weather days) at City Hall property, near the storage shed on the South side of the campus. Distribution nights will be held at dusk: about 7 PM during Daylight Savings Time, and about 6 PM during Standard Time. Deer Management season is October 2, 2017 through February 28, 2018.

Distribution Process:

- Venison will be given on a First-Come, First-served basis until all are distributed for the week.
- One deer only per vehicle, please.
- Animals are field dressed, ready to go to the meat processors, or to be processed by the recipient.
- There is no charge to receive a donated animal.
- Animal cannot be sold – all state game laws apply.
- Preference may be given to Granite Shoals residents.

We designed this new process to hopefully streamline the process.
